




Dispatcher Phoenix

Updating Dispatcher Phoenix To Version 4.0

#1. Determine current version

First, you should find out what version of Dispatcher Phoenix you are currently running. Select the **About Dispatcher Phoenix** option from the **Help** menu, as in the following illustration:



#2. If Running Version 3.0 or Higher

Select the **Check for Updates** option from the **Help** menu.

- If your version is currently at the release-level, a message will appear, as in the following illustration:




In this case, no updates are required; select the **Close** button on the message box.

- If updates are available, the following message will appear:



Updating Dispatcher Phoenix To Version 4.0

1. Select the **Continue** button on the message box to launch the Add-In Manager with the **Select Updates From** option displayed, as in the following illustration:



2. Select the **Run as administrator** button; then select the **Yes** button in the User Account Control message that appears.
3. On the Add-In Manager window, select the **Install Updates** button to update the application.

#3. If Running Version 2.5 or Higher


Older versions of Dispatcher Phoenix (Version 2.5 and above) may display the following error message after you check for updates:



In this case, do the following:

1. Launch the Add-In Manager (**Windows Start > Programs > Konica Minolta > Add-In Manager**).
2. Select the **Options** button. The Add-In Manager Options window will appear, as in the following illustration:

3. In the **Remote Config File** field, change the URL listed to:
<http://dev1.sec.kmbs.us/api/pools/release/packages.xml>
4. Select the **Save** button to save your changes and return to the Add-In Manager window.
5. On the Add-In Manager window, select the **Run as administrator** button; then select the **Yes** button in the User Account Control message that appears.
6. Select the **Install Updates** button to update the application.
