

Updating Dispatcher Phoenix To Version 4.0

#1. Determine current version

First, you should find out what version of Dispatcher Phoenix you are currently running. Select the **About Dispatcher Phoenix** option from the **Help** menu, as in the following illustration:



#2. If Running Version 3.0 or Higher

Select the Check for Updates option from the Help menu.

• If your version is currently at the release-level, a message will appear, as in the following illustration:



In this case, no updates are required; select the Close button on the message box.

• If updates are available, the following message will appear:





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1. Select the **Continue** button on the message box to launch the Add-In Manager with the **Select Updates From** option displayed, as in the following illustration:



- 2. Select the **Run as administrator** button; then select the **Yes** button in the User Account Control message that appears.
- 3. On the Add-In Manager window, select the **Install Updates** button to update the application.

#3. If Running Version 2.5 or Higher

Older versions of Dispatcher Phoenix (Version 2.5 and above) may display the following error message after you check for updates:



In this case, do the following:

- 1. Launch the Add-In Manager (Windows Start > Programs > Konica Minolta > Add-In Manager).
- 2. Select the **Options** button. The Add-In Manager Options window will appear, as in the following illustration:

- 3. In the Remote Config File field, change the URL listed to: http://dev1.sec.kmbs.us/api/pools/release/packages.xml
- 4. Select the Save button to save your changes and return to the Add-In Manager window.
- 5. On the Add-In Manager window, select the **Run as administrator** button; then select the **Yes** button in the User Account Control message that appears.
- 6. Select the Install Updates button to update the application.
